Curriculum

Our curriculum is one that is appropriately adapted to have a positive impact on the needs of our pupils: it is based on their interests, whilst ensuring depth of learning as our curriculum intention is to be broad, balanced and prepare our pupils for life in the 21st century.

Policies

All our school policies are based on pupils with special needs and are available from school; many are also available on our website. Our Admissions Policy is through the Local Authority. We are a fully inclusive school.

Collective Worship

We have daily collective worship for all pupils that is based in Christianity. As a parent/carer, you have a right to withdraw your child from this.

Anti-Bullying

We are completely opposed to bullying in any of its forms and it will not be tolerated in our school. The anti-bullying policy, procedures and sanctions are approved by the school Governors. Pupils breaking this code will be disciplined in accordance with the school's procedures.

E-Safety

All pupils are taught safe use of the internet and made aware of the associated risks.

Safeguarding Children

Parents and carers should know that the Headteacher, as the school's Designated Safeguarding Lead, is required to report any obvious or suspected cases of child abuse to social services, including sexual, physical, emotional and neglect. This procedure is intended to protect children but does mean that this may be upsetting to parents and carers.

It is hoped that you will accept that we are acting in your child's best interest. All staff are trained in de-escalation techniques. This is a system based on making sure all children are treated fairly and are kept safe from hurting themselves and others.

Mr M Gallafent is the Governor with responsibility for child safeguarding and he can be contacted through the school.

School Uniform

Lower School

Red sweatshirt, black or grey trousers or skirt, white polo shirt, black shoes; no trainers please. Red checked dresses are optional.

Upper School

Black school sweatshirt, black or grey trousers or skirt, white polo shirt, black shoes; no trainers please.

Post 16

Smart wear suitable for work, or graphite grey polo shirts and hoodies are available to purchase from school.

PE/Swimming Kit

Black t-shirt, shorts or tracksuit, trainers and towel. All pupils should be prepared to shower after PE/swimming. Please note the use of spray deodorants is not allowed in school. One-piece swimming costume or swimming trunks (no shorts) and towel. Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name.

School sweatshirts and PE t-shirts are purchased from the school office.

Pupils are not allowed to wear jewellery, make-up or nail varnish in school. They will be asked to remove any make-up, nail varnish or jewellery and any items will be returned to them at the end of the school day. A watch is acceptable and pupils with pierced ears may wear one single stud per ear. In the interests of health and safety, no other body piercings are allowed.

Pupils are not allowed mobile phones in school. In an emergency, should they need to contact or be contacted by parents and carers, they will be allowed access to the school phone. Any mobile phones brought into school should be handed in at reception along with any other personal items, for example, tablets, games and other toys.

Chewing gum is not allowed in school and hats are not to be worn inside the school building.

Attendance

If for any reason a pupil is absent from school, please inform us, as early as possible, on the first day and on any subsequent days of absence.

As parents and carers, you have a legal duty to make sure that your child attends school regularly and therefore leave of absence must not be requested in term time.

It is your responsibility as parents and carers to ensure that your child catches the school transport.

School Meals

As a healthy school we provide delicious, healthy and nutritious school meals that are prepared daily on the premises. These include a wide range of both hot and cold food. (Menus can be accessed by school's website).

The cost of the meals is currently £2.60 per day for all pupils.

Meals need to be paid for in advance on a Monday morning.

Dinner money is payable through ParentPay.

We encourage pupils to drink water throughout the school day.
